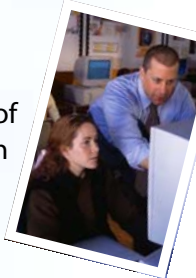


"Most of the people we meet in life are just occasionally in need of a helping hand-up, not a continual hand-out."

their own way through regular employment.

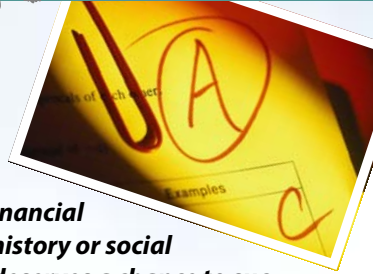

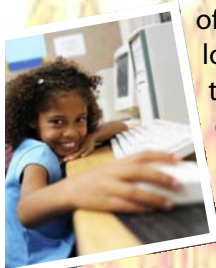
